BARRIERS

- Entrance Criteria for Prep and Success

 - Action Plan: Building professional development online courses for incoming paras to assist with learning behavior management, intervention programs etc.
- Math Interventions
 - Action Plan: Training will be provided next school year on how to utilize our math data to better identify tools for intervention
- Online SWIS Entry for Paras
 - Adding all MTSS paras to SWIS online entry for next year
