A DIT meeting was held on 5/17/21. The following agenda items were discussed:

Celebrating District Accomplishments

- Middle School
 - Making Revisions to Multi-Tiered Systems of Support to better group students to provide more targeted support. MTSS staff will be returning next year
 - More coordination and planning for 7th and 8th grade Advisory Classes
 - By May 23rd, every student will have experiential learning along with problem solving experiences in the career path
- High School
 - Working on student rosters for Hawkeye Success and Hawkeye Prep support classes for next fall- 4 teachers have been assigned to teach these courses
 - A new student recognition award that reached 156 students and celebrated growth
 - Will be awarding end of year drawing gifts for PBIS
- Elementary
 - Celebrating reading growth on Acadience and i-Ready
 - After school running groups and Kids Hope

Subcommittee Updates

- Student support team at the High School identifying students to participate in support courses
- High School Reading Intervention Committee piloting assessment to target intervention needs
- Vocabulary Subcommittee implementing consistent academic vocabulary lists and strategies next year
- Elementary Tier $\frac{2}{3}$ Behavior Implementing methods for tracking student progress in interventions and tracking our fidelity of providing interventions
- Elementary Tier $\frac{2}{3}$ Reading implementing procedures for tracking student history of intervention, procedures when a student is not responding to intervention, and reviewing pilot programs used for 3rd and 4th grade
